ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Union members (in good standing with the Local) leaving work full-time on an approved leave of absence to upgrade their education OR Dependants (under the age of 25) of a member (in good standing with the local) continuing with a Post-Secondary Education
- Must be in first year attendance at any recognized University, Teachers College or Community College in the Province of Ontario

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Duly completed print or digital application form
- Two letters of recommendation. The letters of reference must be signed and must clearly indicate the name and contact information of the referee. References can be any of the following:
 - Past or present employer
 - Teacher
 - Advisors and coaches

References from family members will not be accepted

- Copy of Letter of Acceptance to a recognized University, Teachers College or Community College in the Province of Ontario
- Certified copy of graduation or final marks

APPLICATION FORM

All applications to be considered must be fully completed and submitted within the specified time period which is August 1st to October 15th of each calendar year. SELECTION

CUPE Local 905 Scholars are selected through a rigorous process comprised of the following stages:

1. The Treasurer will review all applications received for the period beginning August 1st and ending October 15th of each calendar year.
2. Evaluation of all applications by the Signing Officers of *CUPE Local 905*
3. A recommendation from the Treasurer in consultation with the other Signing Officers shall be presented to the Executive Board for consideration and endorsement

SELECTION CRITERIA

Applications must be on the prescribed form and must be received by the Treasurer of *CUPE Local 905* no later than October 15th of each calendar year. All criteria must be adhered to in order for the application to be reviewed.

- Academic achievement, including grades
- Community / extracurricular involvement
- Leadership
- Aptitude & promise
